






Transworld Group partners with UAE Alliance for Climate Action

In an economic and social scenario in which transparency is becoming increasingly important, it is imperative for the organisation to have high corporate governance standards coupled with Risk management and Compliance. In the year 2007, the term GRC was coined which means Governance, Risk Management and Compliance. It refers to any organisation's strategy for handling its governance, risks and compliances. The first scholarly research on GRC was published in 2007 where GRC was formally defined as "the integrated collection of capabilities that enable an organization to reliably achieve objectives, address uncertainty and act with integrity."



The overall purpose of GRC is to reduce risks and costs as well as duplication of effort. It is a strategy that requires company-wide cooperation to achieve results to meet internal guidelines and processes established for each of these three core areas. Adopting GRC, enhances and enables gathering, sharing and use of internal information and data more efficiently. We at Transworld are cognizant of the advantages of GRC and thus adopt an approach where relevant data is shared internally, thereby facilitating business leaders to drive their actions.

Further, as a compliance team, GRC remains our focus. We adopt and implement the best management practices towards enhanced governance, risk identification and mitigation processes, compliance with regulations in true letter and spirit. We adhere to ethical standards for effective management and discharge of social responsibility for sustainable development of all stakeholders.


