Transworld expands fleet with addition of OEL Varun, OEL Surya and OEL RUDRA



Transworld Group has announced the acquisition of three container vessels — formerly known as Seaspan Loga, Seaspan Hannover, and MV Safesea Yash — which have now been renamed OEL Varun, OEL Surya, and OEL Rudra respectively. The vessels come with capacities of 2,478 TEUs and 3,398 TEUs.

The acquisition marks a significant addition to Transworld's fleet capacity and underscores the company's ongoing focus on service excellence, sustainability, and operational efficiency.

The vessels are expected to be deployed across key regional and international trade lanes to support increased cargo demand and enhance schedule reliability.

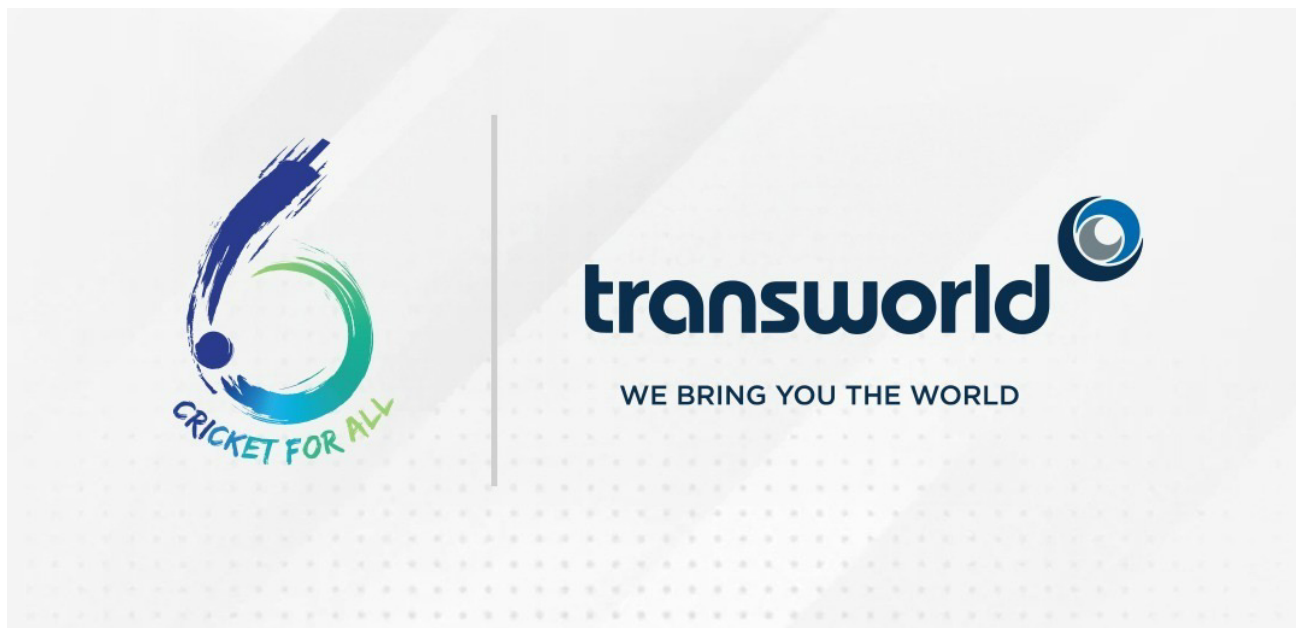
His address reflected Transworld's commitment to engaging in platforms that facilitate meaningful dialogue on the future of logistics, international trade, and sustainable global growth.

At Transworld Jets, we have invested in technology-led processes that help us predict maintenance needs, optimise flight schedules, and maximise aircraft reliability. For me, the essence of private aviation is trust. The certainty that every flight will be smooth, safe, and executed with precision. That is what modern luxury represents. Seamlessness, discretion, and consistent performance.

This belief shapes our operating philosophy. We do not sell flights. We craft experiences. A charter journey is more than a point-to-point movement. It is a personalised & thoughtful experience that reflects the traveller's rhythm and expectations. Luxury today is subtle and service-driven and it is rooted in reliability rather than extravagance.



Building What India Needs: A Scalable, Skilled, Responsible Future

For India's charter industry to grow sustainably, we need structural clarity and capability. Clear policies around aircraft import, taxation, and maintenance approvals will unlock investment. Dedicated business aviation terminals and regional MRO facilities are essential for smooth and efficient operations. Above all, the sector needs specialised talent, from charter-trained pilots and engineers to service-focused cabin crew.

This is why we operate Transworld Jets on a vertically integrated model that combines luxury air charter, MRO, and specialised air freight. Integration gives us full control over engineering quality, safety standards, and customer experience. Standardisation and discipline must become the backbone of our industry if we want to achieve global credibility.

Technology will accelerate this journey. Real-time availability, transparent pricing, predictive analytics, and digital fleet management will define the next era of business aviation in India. At Transworld Jets, we have embraced these tools, but technology should always enhance human service and not replace it. Personal touch and human intuition remain the core of private aviation.

The future must also be responsible. Sustainability can no longer be treated as optional. From adopting fuel-efficient practices to optimising routes and preparing for Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF), our industry must embed environmental responsibility into its operational DNA. At Transworld Jets, our MRO division is designed around efficient resource use and waste reduction. We intend to be among the early adopters of SAF in India once it becomes commercially feasible.

For new entrants and investors, my advice is simple. Treat this as a disciplined service business. Operational credibility is more important than scale. Understand the regulatory landscape, invest in safety, and build your reputation one flight at a time. In my experience, clients return for dependability, not discounts. That is where lasting value lies.

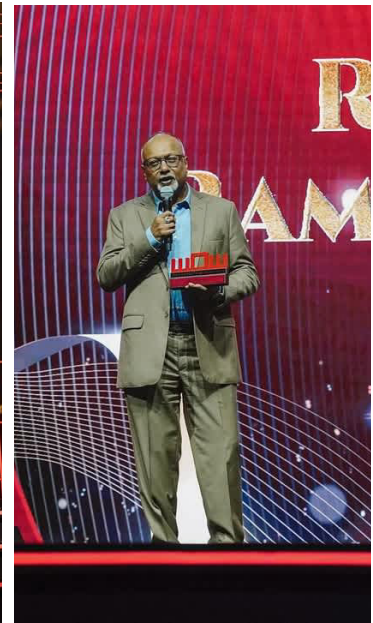

Sustainability Initiatives: Driving Positive Environmental Change:



As part of Transworld's commitment to sustainability, a series of initiatives were organized focusing on environmental conservation & responsible practices. From awareness-building discussions to observable behaviour changes among employees, these efforts supported marine stewardship, community engagement, and eco-friendly actions, reinforcing Transworld's drive for long-term, sustainable impact.

(a) Impact Power Talks Series: Inspiring Collective Action for a Sustainable Future

We launched the Impact Power Talks Series to bring together changemakers, thought leaders, and grassroots champions to inspire sustainable action.

The inaugural session, "From Cleanups to Culture Change: What It Really Takes to Live Sustainably," featured external speakers, Ceejay Nadeen (DulSCO Group), Bijaya Kumar Kabi (APOWA), and Amita Deshpande reCharkha), moderated by Shipra Saxena (Transworld), with 119 participants joining from across the community, NGOs, and Transworld employees.

(b) Paper Waste Reduction Campaign: Small Actions, Big Impact:-

Last year, Transworld offices printed over 1 million sheets of paper, equivalent to the loss of 108 trees, 108,800 litres of water, and nearly 217,600 kg of CO₂. While printing is essential, unnecessary or duplicate prints contribute to resource depletion and landfill waste.

To address this, we launched the Paper Waste Reduction Campaign across select areas in Dubai and Mumbai offices, encouraging mindful printing and segregation of paper waste for recycling. The initiative led to collection of 11,500 sheets which would have otherwise ended up in waste, thereby diverting 58 kg of paper from landfills.

This initiative reflects Transworld's commitment to sustainability, proving that even small changes in daily work habits can create a meaningful environmental impact.



(c) Paper Waste Recycling Workshop: Turning Waste into Worth:-

Aligning with the Paper Waste Reduction Campaign, we organized a Paper Recycling Workshop across Dubai and Mumbai offices to demonstrate how small individual actions can collectively reduce paper waste.

47 enthusiastic volunteers participated, learning to transform used paper into handmade recycled sheets, which were later used to create artwork and meaningful quotes. The workshop emphasized mindful printing, responsible waste segregation, and the environmental benefits of recycling, fostering a culture of sustainability and eco-conscious practices within the workplace.



Transworld's Green Legacy: Agroforestry for Impact

As part of Transworld's 6th Corporate Responsibility Day in 2024, the organization pledged to plant 500,000 trees by 2027, marking its 50th anniversary and reaffirming its commitment to environmental stewardship and sustainable development.

Under this vision, the Agroforestry Project was launched to promote ecological restoration, biodiversity, and sustainable livelihoods. In collaboration with Grow Billion Trees, 14 Transworld volunteers recently planted 55 trees in Vadodara, contributing to long-term reforestation efforts and livelihood generation.

To date, over 144,000 trees have been planted across Gujarat, Odisha, and Jharkhand with partners Grow Billion Trees and Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham. The initiative has also engaged 150+ farmers, equipping them with agroforestry skills and creating sustainable livelihood opportunities.

Transworld aims to reach 150,000+ trees by year-end, strengthening its mission to restore ecosystems and support community resilience.



Health, Food and Water Security:

National Nutrition Week 2025: Nourishing Lives, Inspiring Change



In September, we marked National Nutrition Week, reaffirming Transworld's commitment to care and community. Aligned with Rashtriya Poshan Maah and the UN SDGs of Zero Hunger and Good Health & Well-being, the initiative raises awareness on nutrition and healthy living.

This year, 50 volunteers across 6 locations - Mumbai, Delhi, Chennai, Tirupur, Kochi, and Vadodara - served 8,834 nutritious meals to 739 orphaned children, in partnership with organizations including Oneness, Pratibha Foundation, Prayas, SEAL Ashram, Sri Arunodayam, TISSO, and Willingdon Island Government High School.

The initiative continues to reflect Transworld's commitment in creating social impact, one meal, one smile at a time.

Around the festival, we hosted our annual Diwali Corporate Bazaar in Mumbai, Delhi, and Dubai offices, welcoming local NGOs to set up stalls showcasing their handmade products. The Bazaar created opportunities for young People of Determination (PoD) artists, children, blue-collar women, and rural women to display their talent and connect with employees.

- 105+ volunteers engaged in meaningful giving initiatives

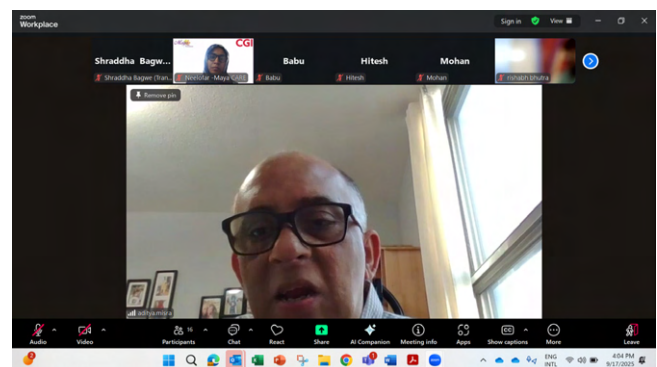
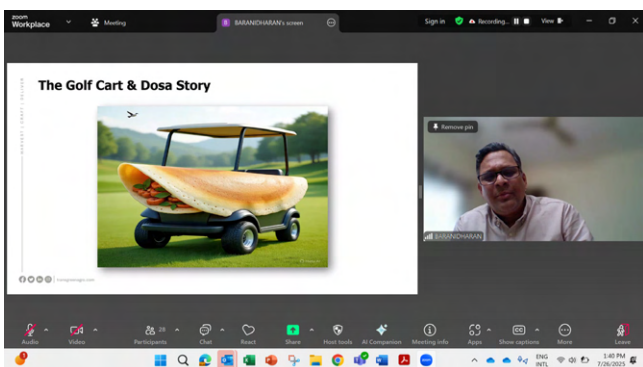
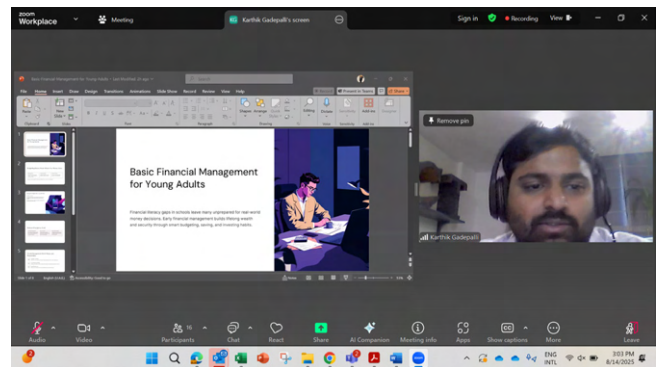
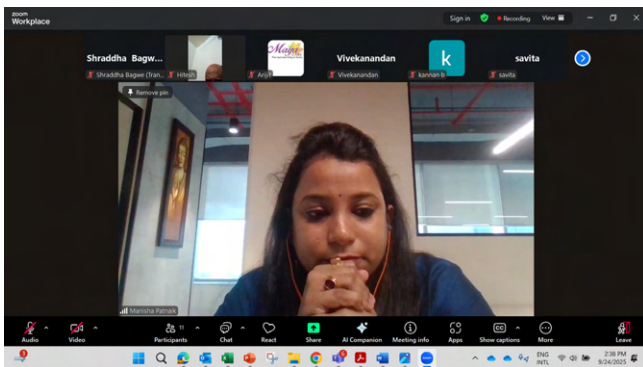
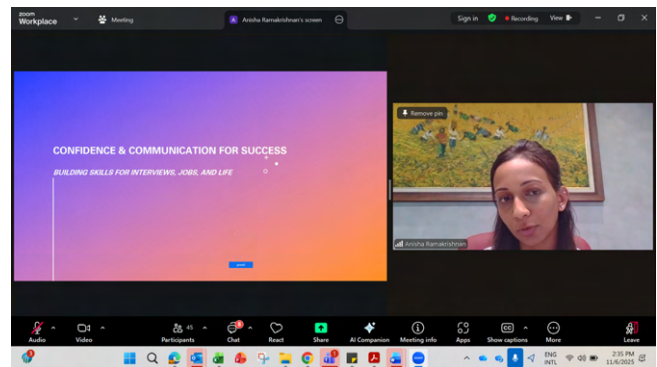
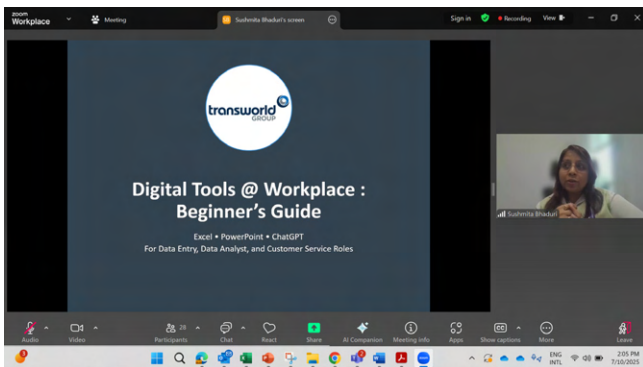
Individual Volunteering: #YouCan Campaign 2025

Through this flexible and skill-based model, we continue to foster deeper and long-term engagement. We have received contribution of 29 volunteers across different initiatives to create consistent impact.

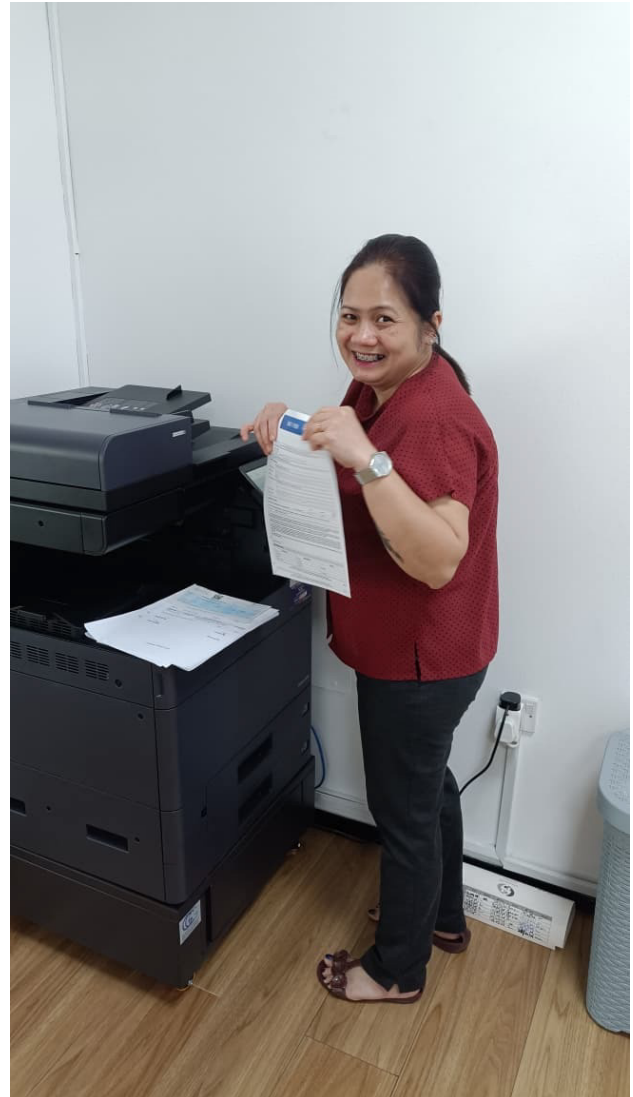


Eco-Warrior of the Quarter: Ms. Minette Mungcal

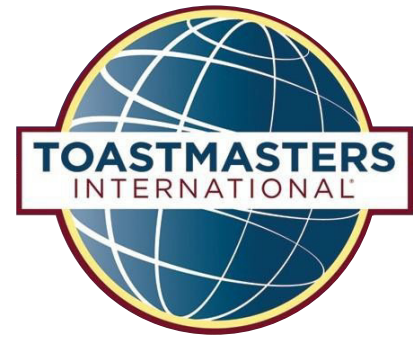
