Long-Term Partnerships in Action: Project Spotlight

Beyond short-term initiatives, Transworld actively collaborates with NGOs on long-term projects, driving sustainable community impact through financial and capacity-building support. Here, we highlight some of these initiatives.

Project Toofan – Empowering Rural Athletic Dreams

In partnership with the **NGO, Bridges of Sports**, Transworld is nurturing young athletic talent from underrepresented tribal communities and transforming raw potential into India's fastest sprinters. The program provides structured coaching, mentorship from international trainers, psychology sessions and other essential support like travel, nutrition, and education.

Location: Karnataka (India)

Impact:

- 26 athletes are being trained of which 6 are receiving international coaching support
- 18 athletes have competed at the national level
- 2 athletes have proudly represented India on international platforms



Agroforestry for Livelihood and Environmental Impact

Transworld has pledged to plant **500,000 trees by 2027**, marking its 50th anniversary. In partnership with **NGOs – Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham and Grow Billion Trees**, Transworld supports the agroforestry project for ecological restoration and local livelihood generation, while enhancing soil fertility, carbon sequestration, and biodiversity. It also addresses poverty, malnutrition, and human-wildlife conflict.

Location: Gujarat, Jharkhand and Odisha (India)

Impact:

- 144,000+ trees planted so far, with a target of 162,000 by year-end, supporting ecosystem restoration and biodiversity
- 150+ farmers engaged, gaining sustainable livelihoods and agroforestry skills
