Long-Term Partnerships in Action: Project Spotlight

Beyond short-term initiatives, Transworld actively collaborates with NGOs on long-term projects, driving sustainable community impact through financial and capacity-building support. Here, we highlight one of these initiatives.

Protecting the Olive Ridley Sea Turtles

Olive Ridley sea turtles are vulnerable species that are a vital part of our marine ecosystem. Odisha's coast hosts the world's largest nesting sites, yet these turtles face severe threats from unsustainable fishing and predator attacks to plastic waste and discarded nets. **Since 2021, Transworld has partnered with APOWA (Action for Protection of Wild Animals),** a grassroots NGO in **Odisha (India)** to protect these gentle creatures and their nesting beaches. Together, we've created a community-led marine conservation model involving scientific conservation, beach cleanup initiatives, capacity building and education programs.



Impact till date

- **980,000+ hatchlings safely released** into the sea
- **35% increase in hatchlings released since 2021**
- **6,500+ community members engaged** in conservation
- **57,000+ kg of waste collected** from the beaches
